

Chuck Close had difficulty in school. He suffers from dyslexia and struggled with all aspects of school work except art. He was not popular and a neuromuscular condition kept him from playing sports.

In 1988, Close suffered the sudden rupture of a spinal artery. After the incident, Close was left almost entirely paralyzed (*quadriplegic*.) Through therapy he was able to learn to move his arms and paint again.
