

Grading Policy

Ms. Haire's Virtual Art Class



How will art work be given and graded each week?

- Starting Monday, April 20, 2020, you will see assignments from your teachers with the titles MA:# 1, 2, 3...etc. This stands for Mandatory Assignment 1, 2, 3 etc.
- Every week in art, you will receive 3 assignments worth 1 point each. Assignments will be given on Mondays at 8am, and should be turned in by 3:00PM on Friday for me to grade.
- I may choose to give only two assignments, one worth 2 points, and the smaller one worth 1 point.
- Each week, all (3) assignments will be compiled into a grade of **1 of 3 (33%)**, **2 of 3 (66%)** or **3 of 3 (100%)**. These three grades are your only grade options for each week of work.
- Your overall art grade average will be compiled from each of these weekly grades. You will be able to see your progress in Google Classroom.

Can I use online references to help me draw or get ideas?

- **ALL SUBMITTED WORK MUST BE DONE BY YOU (the artist)**. If you plagiarize or steal another artist's work from online, I will give you a 0 on the assignment. **All drawn work by you (not photography) must be SIGNED by you so that I can read your name on your assignment.**
- However, you guys know that artists use reference, like we do in class, to sometimes look up an animal, celebrity, etc. This is okay, but all artwork must come from your hand. Do not trace. That's not how you improve.

I need your help with an assignment!

- Ms. Haire is available within a reasonable time to help any student who has a question or needs feedback on an assignment.
